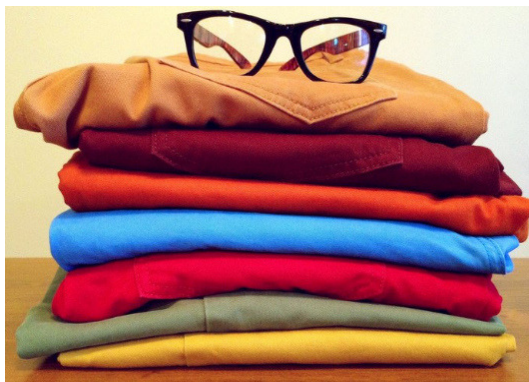

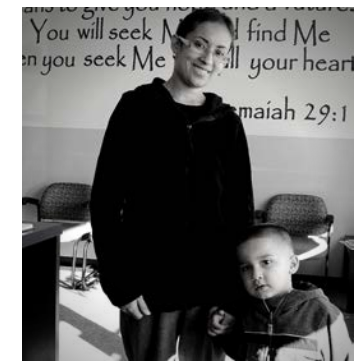

## OUR PROGRAMS



### QUALITY CLOTHING

Clients can visit us up to four times a year and receive quality clothing for each family member including one pair of new socks and new underwear.



### HOMELESS SERVICES

For our clients identifying as homeless we can provide storage lockers, mail boxes and weekly laundry service.



### PERSONAL HYGIENE

We provide small hygiene kits at every visit and new families receive a welcome kit with full size hygiene items.



### SUPPORT AND OUTREACH

We partner with other nonprofits to provide classes and support groups free of charge with the goals of crisis support and fostering independence.



### BACK TO WORK

Clients can receive one pair of new steel-toed work boots when required for employment.



### HOUSEHOLD LINENS

Clients may request sheets, towels or a blanket at each visit.



### COMMUNITY PROJECTS

We contribute socks and underwear to City of Chandler's Back-to-School drive and provide clothes and backpacks as needed to school health offices.



### SHARE OUR SURPLUS

We partner with more than a dozen local and international non-profit organizations to supply clothing we cannot use, expanding our reach to thousands of other families.
